Preparatory work in the classroom

Make sure that the entire team is informed about the material and that your school has a clear idea of how you want to implement identity and sexuality education. This also includes a biblical-theological discussion of the topic.

Familiarise yourselves with all the materials (teacher and parent materials). You should definitely adapt the discussion questions in the PowerPoints for the parents' evenings to your setting. This is about the question of how openly and in what context you can and should talk at the parents' evening.

Training

Working with parents

As the most important educational partners, parents must be fully involved.

Wonderfully Made relies on close cooperation with parents and the children's families of origin. To this end, there are various information and a support booklet for parents as well as a PowerPoints for the parent evening. Teachers should be familiar with these materials.



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Communication and implementation

It is advisable to communicate openly BEFORE the start of school which concept is used at your school and that identity and sexuality education are taught in a spiral curriculum and that the Wonderfully Made concept is based on biblical statements about being human.

It is advisable to invite both parents to the first parents' evening.

The topics of Wonderfully Made are presented to the parents in a way that fits the school year and can be discussed at the parents' evening. The general information booklet provides a good overview at the beginning of the school career of all the topics that will be dealt with during the primary school years.

Reflection

Involve the parents or parent representatives closely in the work, especially at the beginning. Wonderfully Made will change and influence the language skills among colleagues and in the parents' homes, it will change your work in the school and make the children more open and attentive. All of this requires joint reflection with colleagues and parents.
